Fire protection for mobile and transportable equipment

The Seminar

AS 5062 applies to the design, installation and operation of fire protection equipment on land-based mobile and transportable equipment. This includes mining, forestry, construction and rail equipment. It applies to water, foam and gaseous fire extinguishing systems.

AS 5062 adopts a risk-based approach to the use of fire protection systems instead of specifying prescriptive approaches.

The seminar will provide detailed information on the standard and how it relates to heavy mobile and transportable equipment. It will also discuss the risk-based approach from a regulator's viewpoint as well as that of fire protection system manufacturers, installers and operators.
