A one day seminar providing updates across the passive fire protection industry.

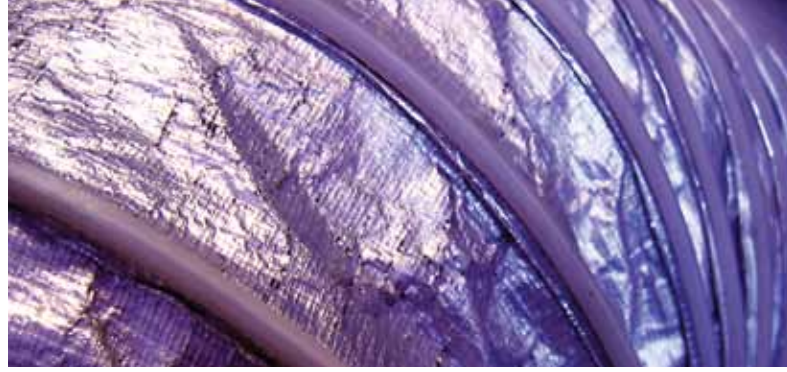
The seminar will address

The program offers something for everyone.

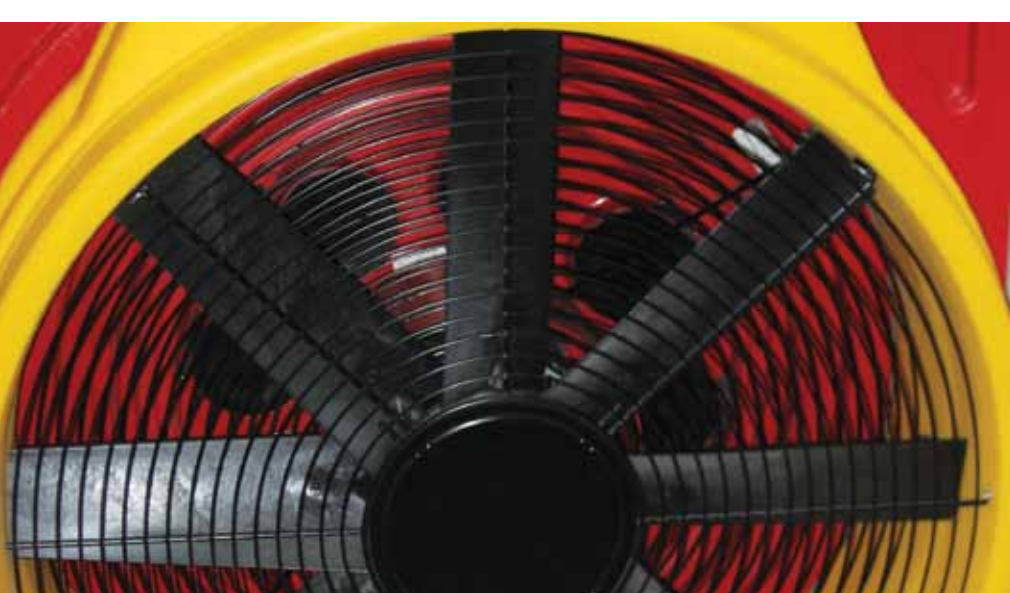

He is now playing with fire on his own.
