Competency

Competency PRMPFES43A Prevent ozone depleting substance and synthetic greenhouse gas emissions.

All applicants must have successfully completed the awareness training competency PRMPFES43A.

Description of Experience

In accordance with the *Ozone Protection and Synthetic Greenhouse Gas Management Act 1989* and its regulations, a person applying for an Experienced Persons Extinguishing Agent Handling Licence (EAHL) must provide information showing that they are suitably experienced.

The information provided must be sufficient to show to the Fire Protection Industry (ODS & SGG) Board that the applicant is highly experienced in carrying out the type of work permitted by each licence.

A statement that a person is working for a company involved in the fire protection industry is not sufficient to show the required level of experience. Applicants must detail the actual work they do and have done. It is unlikely to be regarded as sufficient experience to hold an EAHL if you have less than two years of directly relevant experience.

Supporting information describing all relevant experience for each EAHL being applied for must be included on this form. For any licence not being applied for, the supporting information section should be left blank

To complete this form it is recommended that an applicant must provide at least the following information for each licence being applied for:

- the types of systems and extinguishing agents worked on,
- the length of time the applicant has worked with each extinguishing agent and fire system,
- the role(s) the applicant has had and a clear description of what work they actually did, and
- details of any relevant competency assessments (including in-house training).

Insufficient information will be likely to lead to a delay in assessing an application and may lead to its rejection.

Experienced Persons Licences are Transitional Licences

An Experienced Persons EAHL is a transitional licence granted to allow experienced operators to continue to work with extinguishing agents. Over time a person holding an Experienced Persons EAHL must obtain the relevant competencies to convert their licence(s) to Qualified Persons EAHL(s).

1. Portable Fire Extinguisher Maintenance Licence

Supporting information – Complete this section only if you are applying for this licence.

Entitlement of Licensee:

To charge and recharge a portable fire extinguisher, and repair the extinguisher valve.

Directly Relevant Experience Include information on the type of extinguishers and your role in repairing, testing and recharging fire extinguishers containing ozone depleting and synthetic greenhouse gases.

2. Fixed System Installation and Decommissioning Licence

Supporting information – Complete this section only if you are applying for this licence.

Entitlement of Licensee:

- To install and decommission a gaseous fire extinguishing system (fire protection equipment) including:
 - to install and disconnect actuation devices (mechanisms) to and from container valves; and
 - to install and disconnect gaseous agent containers, and
 - to install and disconnect any interconnections to other gaseous system containers; and
 - to install and disconnect ancillary equipment connections to manifold and pipework; and
 - to attach and remove transport equipment, such as valve outlet and actuator port caps, plugs and locking devices installed to prevent accidental discharge
- Commission actuation control devices set to operate and engage safety devices as needed and decommission these devices.

Directly Relevant Experience Include information on the type of installation and decommissioning you have done involving ozone depleting and synthetic greenhouse gas extinguishing agents.

3. Fixed System Testing and Maintenance Licence

Supporting information – Complete this section only if you are applying for this licence.

Entitlement of Licensee:

To test and maintain a gaseous fire extinguishing system (fire protection equipment), including:

- (a) to test actuation release systems; and
- (b) to disconnect and reconnect actuation devices (mechanisms); and
- (c) to disconnect and reconnect any interconnections to other gaseous systems containers; and
- (d) to disconnect and reconnect ancillary equipment connections from containers to manifold and pipework; and
- (e) to test actuation devices (mechanisms); and
- (f) to perform any tests and maintenance on any Fire Detection and Alarm System, including any remote operation panel and actuation and control system that interfaces with or forms part of a gaseous fire extinguishing system; and
- (g) to perform any tests and maintenance on gaseous agent containers and ancillary equipment connections from containers to manifold and pipework.

Directly Relevant Experience Include information on the range of fixed systems you have maintained that use ozone depleting and synthetic greenhouse gas extinguishing agents.
